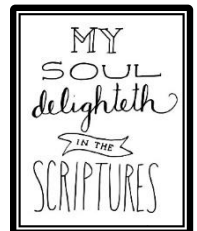

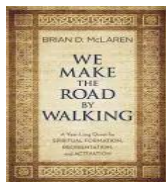
Twelve Women of the Bible - Wednesday, April 24 at 10 am

We Make the Road by Walking - Wednesday, May 1 at 6 pm (Lillestolen home)



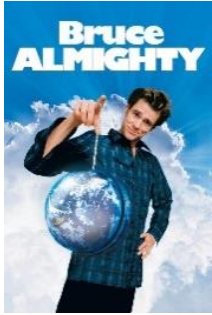
