IT IS IMPORTANT TO LET US KNOW AHEAD OF TIME - preferably by April 30.





The Syrophoenician Woman: Approaching God with Persistency and Boldness Matthew 15:21-28 and Mark 7:26




We Make the Road by Walking - Wednesday, May 1 at 6 pm (Lillestolen home)
