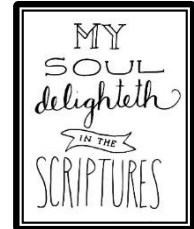

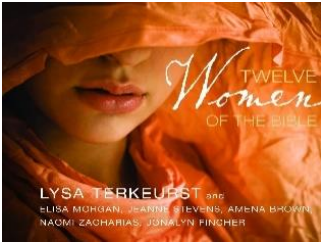

Twelve Women of the Bible - Wednesday, May 8 at 10 am

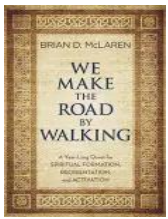


The Wednesday Morning Bible Study has completed the Lysa TerKuerst, Twelve Women of the Bible.
